Writing: identify beginning and some ending sounds; correct usage of upper and lowercase letters; spacing; understandable drawing

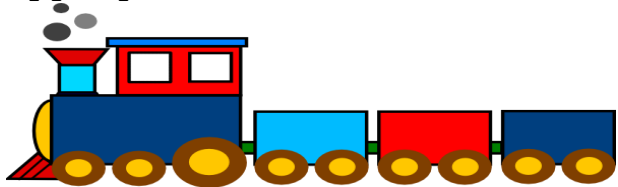
Science: materials and textures; compare and describe attributes; 5 senses; observation reflection
